| City of Douglas                     | Douglas Police Department Building Restoration - The City of Douglas Police Department is housed in a historic building that dates back to the 1910s, and needs repairs to the roof, drainage system, and foundation. This project will enable these long overdue repairs.                                | Douglas AZ               | \$1,300                         |
| Town of Kearny                      | Kearny Fire Truck Replacement - This project will purchase a new fire engine to replace the Town of Kearny's fire truck from 1994, which is becoming more difficult to repair.  | Kearny AZ                | \$600                           |
| Mayer Fire District                 | Mayer Fire District Station Replacement - This project will protect the health and safety of firefighters by helping to replace a fire station that is not NFPA, OSHA or ADA compliant.   | Mayer AZ                 | \$825                           |
| Pinetop Fire District               | Pinetop Wildland Fire Response Station - This project will construct a new wildland fire response station, which will house the district's wildland fire response division. Pinetop Fire District serves a high-risk wildfire community, and this new facility will prevent and combat area wildfires.    | Pinetop AZ               | \$3,274                         |
| Gila County                         | Pleasant Valley Veterans Retreat - This project will convert a former Forest Service fire station into a service center that will help veterans recover from service-related injuries and trauma. This project is a collaborative effort between Gila County and the State of Arizona.                    | Pleasant Valley AZ       | \$333                           |
| Williamson Valley Fire District     | Williamson Valley Fire Station Replacement - This project will replace the district's existing fire station, which is a manufactured home that dates back to 1999, with a new 8,500 square foot station that will better serve the district's needs as a 24/7/365 all hazards emergency and EMS response. | Prescott AZ              | \$750                           |
| Northeast Arizona Training Center   | Northeast Arizona Training Center - This project will complete the construction of new classrooms and training facilities at the Northeast Arizona Training Center, which provides training programs and certifications for law enforcement and fire response personnel in Navajo and Apache counties.    | Taylor AZ                | \$1,979                         |
| Town of Colorado City               | Colorado City Flood Control Project - This project will allow Colorado City, AZ to carry out a Preliminary Investigation Feasibility Report to enable flood control and erosion prevention in the Short Creek Wash. Short Creek Wash runs through the center of Colorado City and periodically floods.    | Town of Colorado City AZ | \$55                            |
| Town of Huachuca City               | Huachuca City Fire Protection - Huachuca City faces a risk of brush and wildfires. This project will allow Huachuca City to replace their aging fire engine and purchase a new rotary tractor/mower to replace the town's currently inoperable mower to better prevent and respond to fires.              | Town of Huachuca City AZ | \$336                           |
| Northern Cochise Community Hospital | Northern Cochise Community Hospital - This project will support the reconstruction of the north entrance and emergency room canopies at Northern Cochise Community Hospital. The current entrance facilities cannot accommodate modern-day vehicle sizes, causing collisions and delays.                  | Willcox AZ               | \$858                           |
