Luke Air Force Base (Gila Bend Auxiliary Airfield)	Gila Bend Consolidated Facility Planning & Design - This project will allow for the planning and design to replace the Control Tower, Fire Station, and Base Operations Complex at Gila Bend Auxiliary Airfield. These improvements will support ongoing operations at the field used by Luke Air Force Base.	Gila Bend AZ	\$2,600
Luke Air Force Base	Luke Air Force Base Child Development Center - This project will construct a new facility capable of serving 250-300 children of servicemembers stationed at Luke AFB. The current Center at Luke AFB is aging and unable to serve the current needs of servicemembers and their families.	Glendale AZ	\$27,000
Fort Huachuca	Fort Huachuca Automated Multipurpose Training Range - This project will construct an Automated Multipurpose Training Range at Fort Huachuca to support mission readiness.	Sierra Vista AZ	\$17,000
Morris Air National Guard Base	Morris ANGB Munitions Storage Complex - This project will fund planning and design required to acquire land and construct a new munitions storage area at the Morris Air National Guard Base. The current storage area is not able to meet minimum safety, security, and capacity requirements.	Tucson AZ	\$2,000
Davis Monthan Air Force Base	Davis Monthan Preservation of the Force and Family (POTFF) Facility - This project will construct an Air Force Reserve POTFF facility to provide proper space for strength training, physical therapy, rehabilitation, mental health, and family counseling, all vital components of troop readiness.	Tucson AZ	\$8,500
Morris Air National Guard Base	Morris ANGB Main Gate Construction - This project will provide additional resources necessary for the Air Force to relocate the main gate at the Morris Air National Guard Base to address security risks and reduce congestion.	Tucson AZ	\$2,000
Marine Corp Air Station (MCAS) Yuma	MCAS Yuma Water Treatment Plant - This project will support the construction of a new water treatment plant to serve the Marine Corps Air Station at Yuma. The current water treatment plant was built in 1947 and is in dire need of replacement to guarantee water quality for Marines and their families.	Yuma AZ	\$73,600
Yuma Proving Ground	YPG Military Free Fall Training Facility - This project will construct a dedicated training facility for the Military Free Fall School at Yuma Proving Ground in support of U.S. Army Special Operations Command. By co-locating training and students, the facility will improve training efficiency.	Yuma AZ	\$52,900
Yuma Proving Ground	YPG Consolidated Rigging Facility - This project will construct a Consolidated Rigging Facility for the Military Free Fall School at Yuma Proving Ground.
