Tonto Basin Fire District	Tonto Basin Fire Station Remodel – This project will renovate the fire station for the Tonto Basin Fire District. The fire station was originally constructed in 1970 and now needs significant upgrades to meet the needs of today's first responders.	Roosevelt AZ	\$158
Town of Superior	Superior Fire Engine – This project will replace a 25-year-old fire engine with a new fire engine for the Superior Fire Department.	Superior AZ	\$718
Town of Taylor	Taylor and Snowflake Fire Equipment - This project will allow the Taylor and Snowflake Fire Department to replace two fire engines and support equipment to reduce fire risk in a wildfire-prone area.	Taylor AZ	\$1,594

City of Willcox	Willcox Fire Equipment - This project will allow the City of Willcox to acquire new hoses, pumps, and other fire response equipment to better respond to fire risks in the region.	Willcox AZ	\$400
