Fort Huachuca	Fort Huachuca Libby Army Airfield Control Tower – This project enables planning and design to replace the Libby Army Airfield Flight Control Tower. Yuma Proving Ground	Yuma Proving Ground Pole Line Road Replacement -- This project will enable planning and design to replace all 21 miles of Pole Line Road and add culvert and shoulders, improving road conditions that are causing severe wear and tear to vehicles and test support equipment.
