A BILL

To amend title 36, United States Code, to designate July
20 as Lunar Landing Day.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lunar Landing Day
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 1 of title 36, United
8 States Code, is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating sections 106 through 115
10 as sections 107 through 116, respectively;

1 (2) by moving section 147 so as to appear after
2 section 105 and by redesignating such section 147
3 as section 106;

4 (3) by redesignating the second section des-
5 ignated as section 106 and sections 107 through 116
6 as sections 107 through 116, respectively;

7 (4) by redesignating the second section des-
8 ignated as 116 and section 117 as sections 118 and
9 119, respectively;

10 (5) by moving section 146 so as to appear after
11 section 119, as so redesignated, and by redesign-
12 nating such section 146 as section 120;

13 (6) by redesignating the second section des-
14 ignated as section 118, the second section des-
15 ignated as section 119, and sections 120 through
16 135 as sections 121 through 138, respectively;

17 (7) by moving section 144 so as to appear after
18 section 138, as so redesignated, and by redesign-
19 nating such section 144 as section 139;

20 (8) by redesignating the second section des-
21 ignated as section 136, the second section des-
22 ignated as section 137, the second section des-
23 ignated as section 138, the second section des-
24 ignated as section 139, and sections 140 and 141 as
25 sections 140 through 145, respectively;

1 (9) by moving section 148 so as to appear after
2 section 145, as so redesignated, and by redesign-
3 nating such section 148 as section 146;

4 (10) by moving the second section designated as
5 section 145 so as to appear after section 146, as so
6 redesignated, and by redesignating such section 145
7 as section 147;

8 (11) by redesignating the second section des-
9 ignated as section 142 and the second section des-
10 ignated as section 143 as sections 148 and 149, re-
11 spectively; and

12 (12) by inserting after section 116, as so redes-
13 ignated, the following:

14 **“§ 117. Lunar Landing Day**

15 “(a) DESIGNATION.—July 20 is Lunar Landing Day.

16 “(b) RECOGNITION.—All private citizens, organiza-
17 tions, and Federal, State, and local governmental and leg-
18 islative entities are encouraged to recognize Lunar Land-
19 ing Day through proclamations, activities, and educational
20 efforts—

21 “(1) commemorating the first successful land-
22 ing of humans on the Moon on July 20, 1969; and

23 “(2) inspiring the continued leadership of the
24 United States in space exploration and science.”.

- 1 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—
