To Whom It May Concern:

Senator Mark Kelly has introduced legislation that says the companies profiting from artificial intelligence have an obligation to the workers that technology displaces. His bill puts real money behind job training, behind paid work that carries a credential, and behind a stronger safety net for people who lose employment through no fault of their own.

My staff at the National Action Network has reviewed the legislation. It is a solid start, and I support it. I use the word "start" deliberately. Legislation changes as it moves, and we intend to be at the table while it does.

We will continue pressing on two points: Who is represented when the spending decisions are made, and whether the communities that absorb the first losses will be among the first to receive help.

I commend Senator Kelly for taking this on, and National Action Network looks forward to working with him to see it through.
